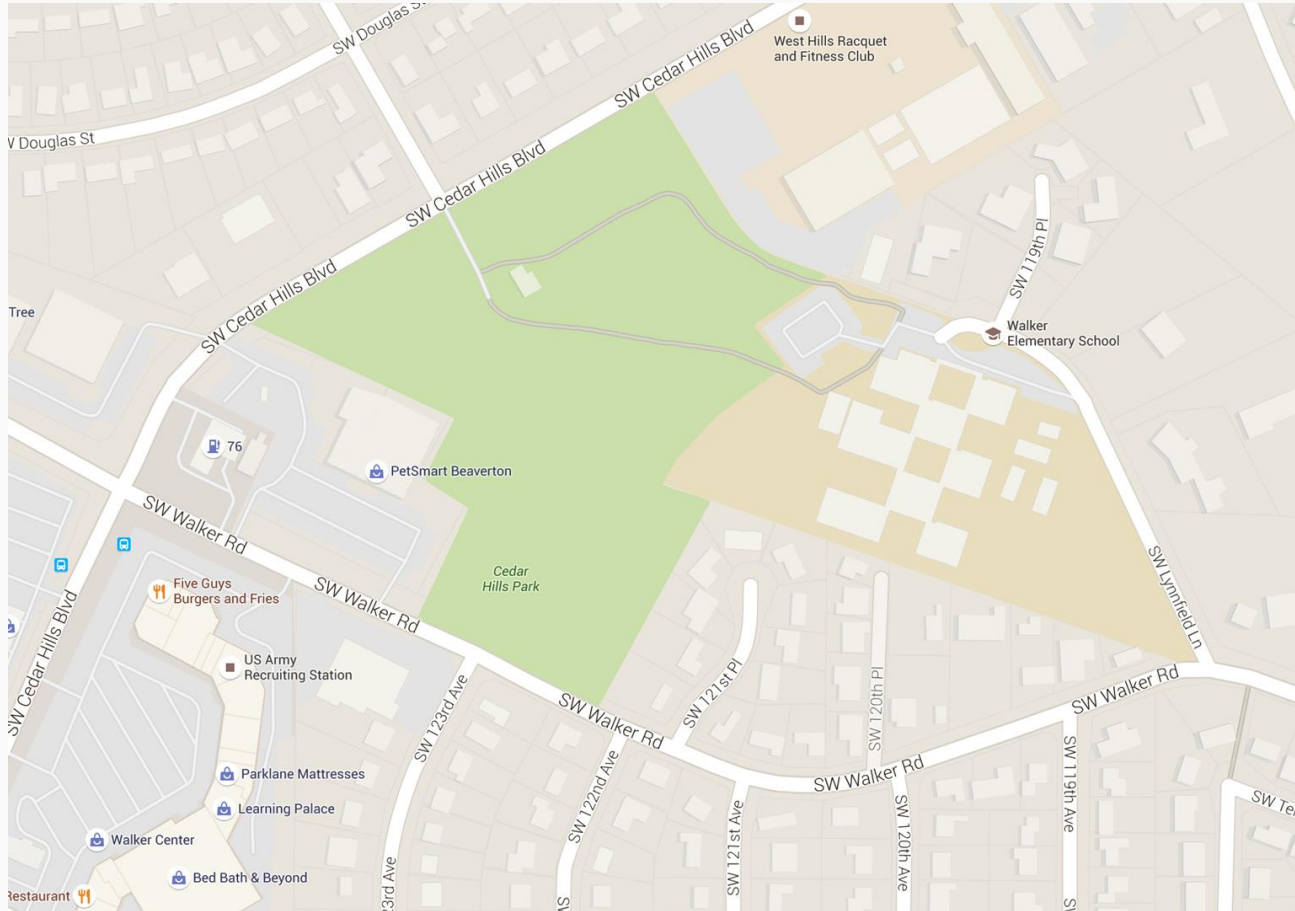


Update:

Joint Access Plan from THRPD and BSD, 3/30/16



Opposition to Park

1. Road through the park, near to the houses on SW 121st
2. Concern for trees
3. Requests a third round of feasibility study to be conducted

Consequences of Opposition to the Park

1. Delay redevelopment of the park
2. Even more trees removed with alternate plan
3. Increase design and planning costs
4. Delay rebuilding of William Walker Elementary School
5. Concern regarding future budget cuts (both THPRD and BSD bond measures are already overbudget)
6. Concern regarding proposed intersection at Cedar Hills Blvd. and Huntington Road

Immediate Update

4pm May 10, 2016:

1. I received news that THPRD and BSD have decided to delay the rebuilding of William Walker Elementary School because of negative feedback
2. It is increasingly important that if you care about the redevelopment of this park and the installation of this new intersection at Cedar Hills Blvd. and Huntington Rd. that you make your voice heard to both THPRD and BSD.
